What to Bring!.... Label all items with Name, not initials Please!!

Dress is casual. Clothes brought to camp need not be new. No uniforms at Camp Q!

For Day Camp:

You... in your clothes, ready to go!
(Long pants or shorts, t-shirt, etc...
Sneakers that stay on your feet with treads good for sports or hikes) and...
Your Stuff... in a Day Pack (medium size, durable with comfy straps) to carry....
Bathing Suit - Bathing Cap if used
Towel & Beach Towel
Tennis Shoes-(smooth sole for clay courts!)
Closed-Toe Sandals or Uggs for the beach (no Flip-Flops, please, for their toes sake!)
Ball Cap or Hat - Sunglasses
Sunscreen - rub on, not spray!
Insect Repellent - roll or rub on - not pump spray or aerosol, please!
Rain Jacket with Hood
Warm, long sleeved shirt
Water Bottle - quart size
Bandana (no, not a banana! lol)
Handkerchief or pack of tissues
Spare pairs of socks & underwear
Digital camera for capturing memories?
Book(s) to read during Rest Period?

Medications: Day Campers have had daily meds before arrival to last until 5:30 pick-up unless otherwise arranged with the Camp Nurse! Resident Campers turn in all meds and pills over to our nurse for issuance as required by their Doctor's Prescriptions.

Medications, Inhalers, Epipens, or Diabetic Supplies must be in original packaging with Prescriptions & Labels attached!

Flip-Flops - only for wear in the shower!
Socks - 10 pair
Underwear - 10 pair

Heavy, Warm Long Sleeved Shirt

Flashlight (hand cranked, so no batteries?)
Camera (digital, w/batteries and memory)
